A Sharing Nature Activity by Joseph Cornell

NOTE TO LEADER:

Have the group form a large circle. Count the number of players and divide the total in half to determine how many animal pairs you will need. If you have an odd number of players, you can designate three players for one of the animals.

Go around the circle with the numbered animal list, and secretly show each player his or her animal. If there are thirty players, for example, give players one through fifteen each an animal; give player sixteen the same animal as player one, player seventeen the same animal as player two, and so on.
