

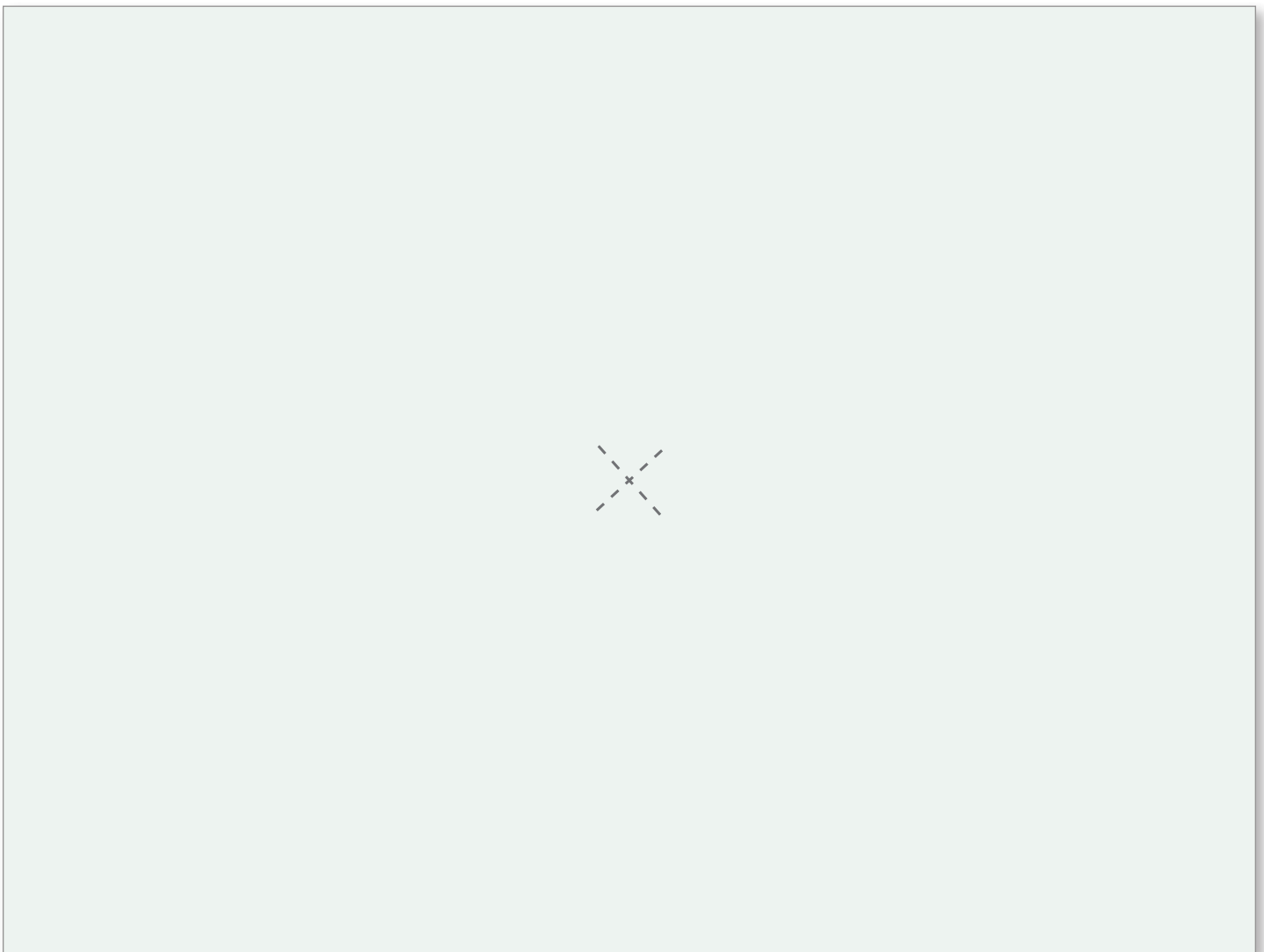
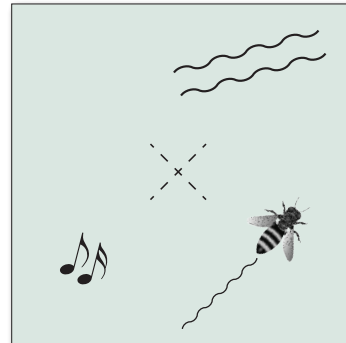
SOUND MAP
